To All of My Seniors,

After meeting with the senior class officers and advisors, we have decided to offer an individual/family style graduation starting on the planned commencement date of June 5, 2020. We do not want to miss any seniors who would not be able to be with us later in the summer. Governor Wolf's movement of the north central region of Pennsylvania from the red to yellow phase allows us to do this now rather than later in the summer. The logistics associated with this event are described in the paragraphs below.

Cap and gown pickup will be Monday, May 18. Last names starting with A through F will be 9 am-noon and last names G through Z will be noon-3 pm. Seniors will come to the front door and must wear a mask and maintain proper social distance. At the same time, you will return all textbooks, calculators, obligations etc. You will receive a bag of personal belongings from your locker. Seniors will also empty their gym locker and retrieve any musical instrument that belongs to them at the same time.

No graduation rehearsal is required for this ceremony. We will teach the graduates when they arrive at commencement at their scheduled date and time. Graduation will be on an individual basis on the front lawn of Muncy High School in 15-minute intervals with the exception of the top five graduates who will be on 30-minute intervals so they can complete their speeches. The order of graduation will be the top five and then in alphabetical order.

Dates and times of commencement are June 5 from noon to 5 pm, June 8 from noon to 5pm, and June 9 from noon to 5 pm. Graduates will be limited to 15 guests so we remain under the number of 25 total for the three days of ceremonies. No tickets will be required because there will only be 15 chairs setup for guests. June 10 will be a rain date if the weather forces us to cancel a day of commencement. We chose to keep our graduation on the front lawn due to tradition knowing that the weather could force us to change, but we felt the Class of 2020 deserves to graduate on our front lawn after all they have been through.

We are still tentatively planning an in-person whole class graduation ceremony on August 7 at 6 pm. We would need the minimum public gathering allowed to be 250 people on August 7 and for Lycoming County to be in the green phase. Since we are not certain of the likelihood of when this may happen, we chose to do the individual/family style commencement to ensure we have the opportunity to celebrate the accomplishments of all our seniors.

Graduation dates and times are listed on the next several pages. Thank you for your patience and cooperation with this change that was made to benefit our seniors under the circumstances we are all under. Be safe and stay healthy.
