Dear Muncy Family,

I hope this letter finds you and your family in good health and enjoying your summer.

The survey link will remain open until Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup>.

Muncy School District will lift the mask requirement for all individuals as of Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> when Pennsylvania lifts the mask mandate for the state. Therefore, effective Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> masks are no longer required in our school buildings or on our school grounds. In other words, masks will be optional for all individuals.

Effective immediately, Muncy School District will lift all other COVID mitigation strategies in alignment with the lifting of Pennsylvania's COVID mitigation strategies as of May 31<sup>st</sup>. In other words, Muncy School District is returning to our standard operating procedures in terms of physical distancing, allowing visitors into our buildings, eliminating temperature screenings etc.

Muncy School District's Board of Education will continue to review the district's health and safety plan each month. If necessary, based on updated requirements or based on Board approval of updates to the 2021-2022 Health and Safety Plan, Muncy School District may reinstitute some of the successful strategies that allowed us to maintain continuous in-person instruction during the past school year.

Please continue to communicate with the school so we can all work together to best meet the needs of our students and families. Since schools are still required to follow contact tracing, isolation and quarantining procedures from the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH), please stay home if you become sick with COVID-19 symptoms, test positive for COVID-19, are unvaccinated and exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms or to someone with a confirmed or probable case of COVID 19 or are vaccinated and exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms or to someone with a confirmed or probable case of COVID 19 and you are currently experiencing symptoms.

We will continue to emphasize proper handwashing and respiratory etiquette, maintaining healthy facilities and coordinating our efforts with state officials, local officials, our students and our families.

Please remember, Muncy School District will completely return to in-person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year. Option 2, which included synchronous live Zoom sessions into classrooms, has been eliminated for the 2021-2022 school year. Please note it may still be necessary for an entire school building to transition to remote instruction for all students from time to time. Attendance policies and procedures will be communicated at the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, including procedures on how students may be able to keep up to date on classroom content and complete assignments during routine absences from school and during extended absences from school due to diagnosed medical conditions or required quarantines.

Additionally, if you choose to have your child(ren) vaccinated as vaccinations become available to K-12 students, please maintain a copy of your child(ren)'s vaccination card. Current Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH) guidance allows asymptomatic, fully vaccinated individuals to avoid quarantining as a result of contact tracing due to an exposure to an individual who has tested positive for COVID.
