Other supplies (such as cap erasers) are optional, but we encourage you take advantage of the sales and stock up.

## You're a 2<sup>nd</sup> Grader!

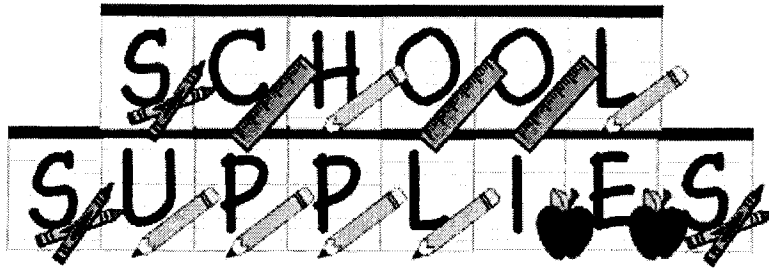
We're so excited that you're coming to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade!

- Fabric Book Cover (regular sized)
- Markers (Crayola markers work best!)
- Pencil Pouch (fabric or plastic is fine)
- Ruler

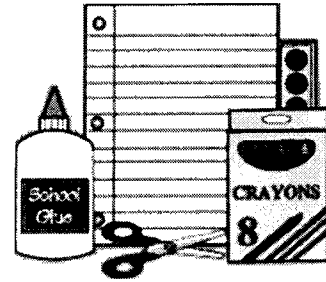
1. Binder (1.5 inch maximum so that it is easy to bring home each day)

**PLEASE do NOT label the notebooks or folders, this will be done in their classes.**

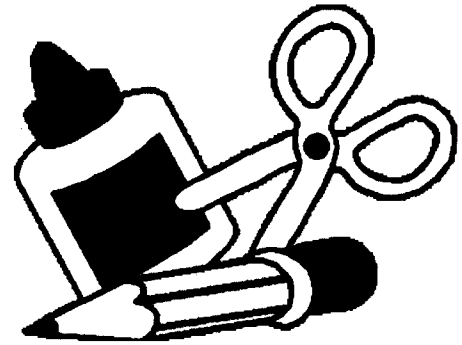
**PLEASE do NOT send in “Trapper Keepers,” expandable folders, 3 ring binders or any type of zippered binder.**

## Fifth Grade Supply List

Students will not be sharing classroom supplies; therefore, we are asking students to bring in the following supplies for their personal use. If you are unable to purchase any of these supplies, we will provide your child with the necessary supplies.

- (3) two-pocket folders
- (3) one-subject notebooks or (1) three-subject notebook
- pencils
- pens
- highlighters
- cap erasers
- 1-JUMBO book cover
- pencil pouch or pencil box
- crayons – no more than 24 pack
- colored pencils
- markers (washable)
- scissors (student-sized)
- glue sticks
- dry erase markers (low-odor) and eraser (can be a clean old sock)
- face mask or face shield
- lanyard (to attach to your face mask)



**\*Please label everything with your child's name; including individual crayons, markers, pencils, etc. when possible.**

**\*PLEASE do NOT send in "Trapper Keepers," expandable folders, 3 ring binders or any type of zippered binder. These are bulky and do not fit in the student's desk.**
