Dear Muncy Family,

I hope this letter finds you and your family in good health.

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with updates related to our school district and to provide you with friendly reminders related to previous correspondence from the school district.

At the school board meeting held on Monday, May 18th, the Muncy School District Board of Directors took action to complete the final steps in our district's continuous progression toward achieving a one-to-one technology status. First, the Board approved a lease for 600 Chromebooks. Second, the Board approved Technology Agreements for both [Muncy Junior Senior High School](#) and [Ward L. Myers Elementary School](#). Together these actions will allow the school district to deploy devices, if necessary, to all students for the start of the 2020-2021 school year. These actions also help to address feedback received throughout our 'School from Home' distance learning solution. Please note we will continue to use received feedback to make additional improvements for the 2020-2021 school year.

The Board also approved the following distance learning programs for this upcoming summer: (a) Kindergarten Readiness Program, (b) Extended School Year (ESY) and (c) Summer School Course Offerings for Muncy Jr. / Sr. High School ([Summer School Course Offerings](#)).

Friendly Reminders

Due to the Memorial Day Holiday, Food Service will operate on Tuesday, May 26th from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

The last day to turn in assignments for seniors will be Friday, May 29th. The last day to turn in assignments for underclassmen will be Wednesday, June 3rd. Teachers will have discretion during the last week of class to complete closure and transition activities with their classes in lieu of formal assignments.

Please see below for the times for students to return all school district materials and pick-up personal belongings from each school building. Muncy Jr./Sr. High School students should report to the front door of the high school. Ward L. Myers Elementary School parents should pull their vehicle into the bus lane at the front entrance. Please be sure to return all applicable school materials such as: (a) textbooks, (b) library books, (c) calculators, (d) athletic uniforms, (e) athletic equipment, (f) reconcile any outstanding lunch debt, etc.

If the times available do not meet your needs please contact the high school office or elementary school office to make alternate arrangements. Please contact us if you need assistance with facilitating return and pick-up for multiple children at multiple grade levels.

Schedule for High School Return / Pick-up

- Tuesday, May 26th – Return / Pick-up for 11th Grade Students (Juniors)
- Wednesday, May 27th – Return / Pick-up for 10th Grade Students (Sophomores)
- Thursday, May 28th – Return / Pick-up for 9th Grade Students (Freshmen)
- Friday, May 29th – Return / Pick-up for 8th Grade Students
- Monday, June 1st – Return / Pick-up for 7th Grade Students

All high school students with last names from A through M should report to the high school front door between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on the date for their grade level specified above.

All high school students with last names N through Z should report to the high school front door between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the date for their grade level specified above.

Please remember to follow the important steps listed below in accordance with the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the Pennsylvania Department of Health.
