

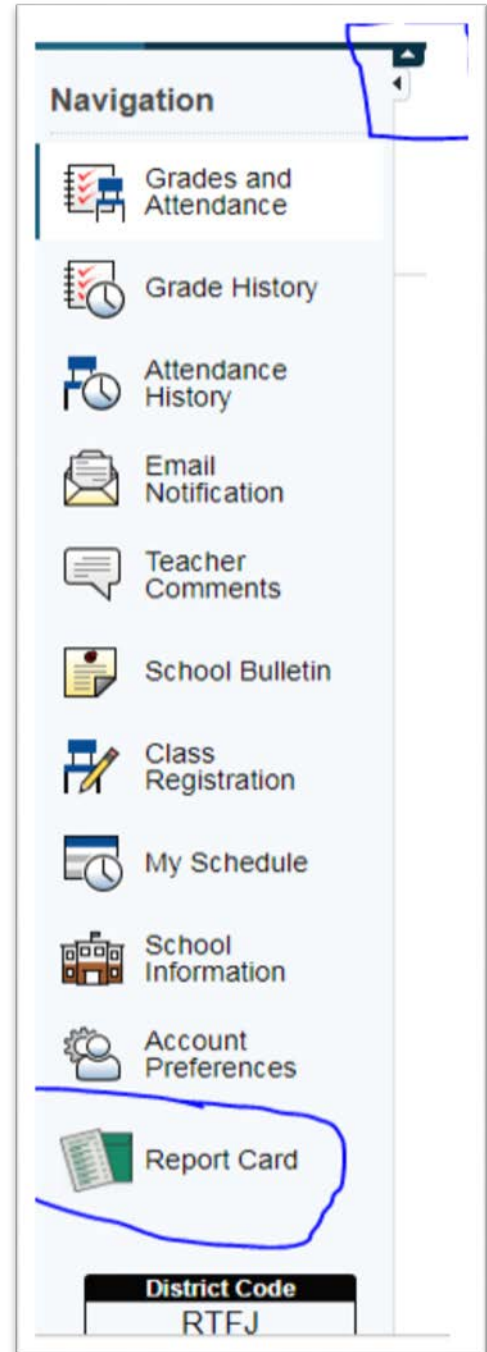
Online Report Card Access Guide

Muncy School District uses online report cards. By clicking on the 'Report Card' icon under the 'Navigation' panel on the left side of the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal screen. The 'Report Card' icon will not be available until 1 p.m. of the day report cards can be accessed. The 'Report Card' icon can only be accessed by logging into the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal through a web browser and cannot be accessed through the PowerSchool Mobile APP.

Please look closely for these arrows on your phone or mobile device as you may need to press one of these arrows to view the navigation screen to see the 'Report Card' icon.

Parent and students can access the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal in one of the following ways using a desktop computer, laptop computer, mobile device or tablet.

1. Click the link (<https://powerschool.muncysd.org/public/>) or copy and paste the link into your web browser.
2. Click on 'PowerSchool Portal' shortcut underneath the 'For Parents' tab or underneath the 'For Students' tab on the school district's website (<http://www.muncysd.org>).
3. Click on the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal Icon in the Muncy School District APP.



Student Access - Students may use their school provided PowerSchool 'Username' and 'Password' to access their online report card. Both the username and password will both be codes containing four capital letters (ex. Username - ABCD; Password - EFGH). Student usernames and passwords have not changed from last year and all new students received their information earlier this school year or upon

their enrollment in the district. Students who may have forgotten their 'Username' or 'Password' may ask for their usernames and passwords in their school building's main office.


Parent / Guardian Access - Parents must create their own 'Username' and 'Password' to access the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal.

Parents who have accessed the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal before and do not remember the 'Username' or 'Password' they created need to contact their student's school office for assistance.

Parents who need access codes should contact the elementary school office, the high school office or the district office to get their 'Access IDs' and 'Access Passwords'.


Parents should complete the following steps once they have all of their access codes for all of their children:

- a. Go to the PowerSchool Parent and Student Portal website (<https://powerschool.muncysd.org>) and click on the 'Create Account' tab and then click 'Create Account'.

- b. Fill out the required information. You will need to create your own 'Username' and your own 'Password' as part of the process. You will also need to enter the parent's 'Access ID', the parent 'Access Password', name of each child and your relationship to each child. The parent 'Access ID' and the parent's 'Access Password' will both be codes containing four capital letters (ex. Access ID - ABCD; Access Password - EFGH) and there

will be different parent access codes for each of your children. ****Please note you must enter your parent 'Access ID' and your parent 'Access Password' for each child to create your parent account. Your child's student username and student password will not work to create your parent account.**** Once all of the information is completed, click 'Enter' at the bottom of the screen.

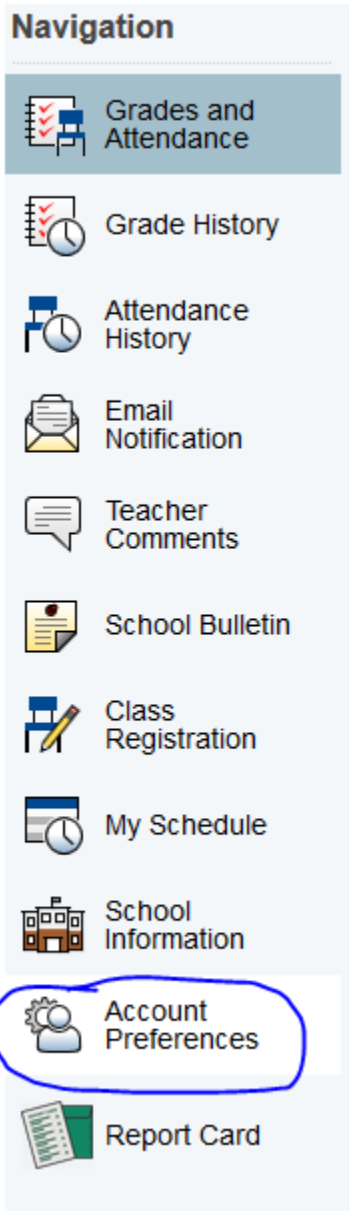

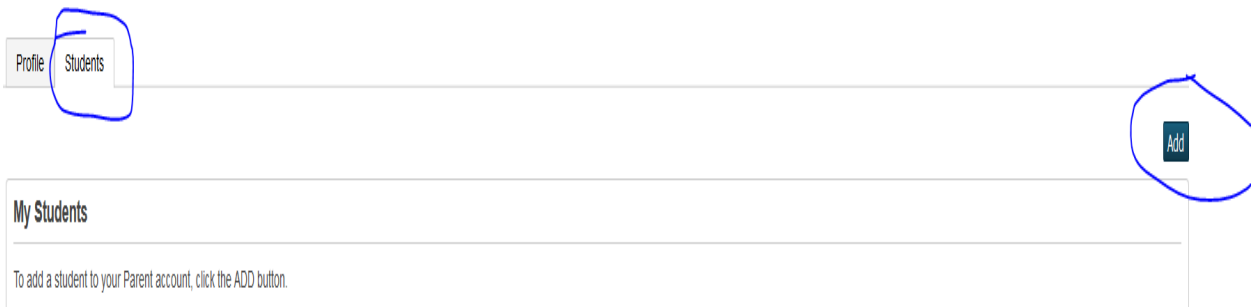
