Byron lettered three years in basketball, one year in tennis and one year in football at Muncy High School. Byron received State honorable mention for small school quarterback. He also led the West Branch in touchdown passes with 13.

At Mansfield University Byron lettered four years in baseball 1980 to 1983. He made the PSAC All East team 3 years, was Mansfield University Male Athlete of the Year in 1983 and was voted Most Valuable Player in baseball for both his 1982 and 1983 campaigns. In 1982 Byron led the Nation in Division II home runs as he pounded out 17 in 28 games. He held the Home run career record with 30 at Mansfield University that stood up for 10 years.

Byron was an Associated Press Pre-season All-American in 1983 at first base and was inducted into the Mansfield University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1995
