Cam was one of the best all-around athletes to graduate from Muncy High School. Cam lettered three years in football, basketball and baseball. His freshman football and basketball teams went undefeated.

In football Cam played quarterback and free safety on defense all three seasons. All three seasons the Indians made district playoffs while in his junior and senior years they won the Mid Penn Championships. Cam received honorable mention honors his sophomore year, made the Mid-Penn All Star team his junior year and was named the league's offensive Player of the Year his senior year. He also served as team captain.

In basketball Cam started all three years and qualified for District play-offs. Muncy won the Mid Penn his junior and senior years. Muncy lost the District final to Lourdes Regional the eventual State Champion. Cam made first team Mid-Penn his junior and senior years.

Cam pitched and played left field for Muncy three seasons. Muncy finished runner-up to Central Columbia. Cam was team captain his senior year.

Cam was named Muncy's Male Athlete of the Year by the West Branch Hall of Fame and he received the 1990 Alumni award.

Cam played three years for Princeton University at the quarterback position and got significant playing time, including during the Tiger's 1992 Ivy League championship season.
