Jim was one of the best middleweights ever to don the Blue & White for the Muncy matmen. Jim lettered three years 1949-50, 50-51, and 51-52. His senior year he won a District IV title at 138 lbs., a Regional championship that allowed him to advance to the state tournament. Unfortunately Jim lost a controversial referee's decision to Pierson of Abington and finished in 4th place. For Jim it was too bad that the match couldn't have been decided on the mat. Needless to say, Jim had a super career. Jim also served as a Co-captain his senior year.

In football Jim was a tough, hard nosed lineman who played guard and went both offense and defense, He served as Co-captain his senior year, while lettering three years.

Jim went on to become a wrestling official for many years and had the respect as one of the best in the state. He refereed in the state Championships several times. He was inducted into the District IV Wrestling Coaches Hall of Fame in 1987.

Jim is a past chairman and is a charter member of the Muncy Athletic Hall of Fame Committee.
