

**TREVOR J. EGLI-Class of 2004**  
**Basketball-Football-Baseball-Coaching**

Trevor was one of the best all around athletes ever to don the blue and white at Muncy High School. Trevor lettered all four years in basketball and started at point guard every single game he played in. He scored 914 points in his stellar career while ripping the cords for 116 three pointers along the way. His best over all season was his junior year as he averaged 12.6 ppg, had 100 assists and 76 steals. The team set a school record best with a 27-4 record, captured the Mid-Penn and District IV titles when they beat Benton by 57-45. They then won three state games before losing to the eventual state champ Scotland. Trevor's senior year started off rough as he missed the first 8 games with a football injury. When he returned Muncy caught fire as they again won the Mid-Penn and went back-to-back capturing another District IV title by knocking off Elkland the defending champ by 43-36 and finished 23-5 overall. The win totals this year and last of 50-9 is a school record.

Trevor lettered three years in football and excelled at the quarterback position. Individually, he was the Mid-Penn League offensive player of the year both his junior and senior campaigns. He went 5 for 11 for 42 yards his soph. year. His junior year saw him go 54 for 108 and 1037 yards,(15 touchdown passes). Trevor's senior year saw him go 98 for 189, 1599 yards and 25 touchdown passes. Totals for his career were 157 for 308, 2678 yards, 40 touchdown passes and 10 interceptions.

In baseball Trevor won Muncy Little League Championships In 1993 and 1994, playing for American Legion Post 268. In high school baseball, he played one year and made the most of it as he was a member of the District IV Champs and reached the State final Championship game as Muncy lost a heart breaker to Neshannock by a 8-4 score. Trevor started in right field and batted .323 his senior season.

Trevor played college basketball at Franklin & Marshall from 2004 to 2006. His teams record overall was 36-19 and he played on the ECAC South Region Champions.

Currently Trevor who earned his PHD in sports psychology and kinesiology, is a assistant men's basketball coach at Johnson University, Knoxville, TN... Welcome to the hall Trevor.
