Pete in receiving the Paul F. Gresh award, his senior year for the Outstanding Male Athlete says it all. Pete's discipline and hard work was a trademark in his career.

In Muncy football he started and lettered his sophomore, junior and senior years. His junior year Muncy went 9-2 and his senior year 7-5 with a big playoff win over Upper Dauphin 49-13. Pete was a 1st team all-conference guard his junior year and 1st team all-conference defensive tackle both his junior and senior years. He served as team captain his senior year and was West Branch Conference co-defensive player of the year. Pete was a District IV All-Star and was nominated to the Big 33.

In Muncy wrestling he joined the team to support the program during a down period of Muncy Wrestling that included three coaches in three years, and saw only five or six wrestlers participating at times. Over the course of three years, he was able to learn and earn the support for Muncy to survive and thrive while leading his team in wins. He won a sectional tournament and qualified for the regional tournament. He was voted most improved wrestler his sophomore year.

In college football at Alfred University, Pete was a four year starter at defensive tackle and a 1st team all-conference defensive tackle selection. He received the Bob Carley award for attitude, commitment and work ethic.

Pete was a member of the National Honor Society and received the H. Porter Rathmell Scholarship to cap off his stellar high school career.
