Dave was one of the most versatile athletes ever to letter at Muncy High School. His over-all athletic ability allowed him to play many positions at a high level of intensity. Dave lettered two years in football at Muncy, 1950-51 and 1951-52. He was a real good half back and an aggressive linebacker. He was a team co-captain his senior year. Dave lettered two years in basketball his junior and senior years and played point guard. He also lettered two years in baseball his junior and senior years. Dave was a catcher and played 3rd base while also utilizing his leadership skills as team co-captain his senior year.

Dave was a letterman at Bucknell University in football 1953, 1955, and 1956. He played a bevy of positions on both offense and defense. The only positions he failed to see action at in his Bison career was center and quarterback on offense. Dave was the ultimate team player and did what ever it took to win.

Dave also coached the Muncy swim team and the swim team at the Y. He also coached tennis and sponsored a Muncy Little League Team for Many years.

Dave has served on the Muncy High School Athletic Hall of Fame Committee since its inception in April of 1976. He is a past chairman of this committee.
