Gerry was a four year letterman in both wrestling and baseball 1948-52. He compiled a 41-5 dual meet record in wrestling. He was the first MHS wrestler to attain 40 wins in a career. Gerry's winning percentage is the third highest in school history behind Hall of Famers Roger Campbell and Dick Brittain. He was District IV Champion in 1952 and runner-up in 1950 while also going undefeated 11-0 in dual meets in 1951-52. Gerry was also leader in team points scored in two of his fours that he competed.

Gerry graduated from Franklin and Marshall College in 1956 where he lettered in both wrestling and baseball. He compiled wrestling and dual meet career records of 21-4-4. Gerry also competed in the 1955 National Championships being the first Muncy wrestler to do so. Gerry was team co-captain his senior year during which he was undefeated in dual meets 11-0 and won the team's Outstanding Wrestler Trophy his senior year. He was selected to F&M Coach Roy Phillips' All-Star team after the conclusion of Phillip's 18 year career.
