Missy in one word is a winner and had a stellar softball career at Muncy High School and Susquehanna University. Missy's domination, fierceness and competitiveness was a driving force in leading her teams to many great wins.

Missy lettered three years for the Lady Indian softballers and held all school pitching records when she graduated. She recorded 119 strikeouts for a season, 312 strikeouts for a career and threw 3 no-hitters.

Missy led her team to 2 District IV playoff appearances and was a team captain her senior and senior seasons. She also was a Mid-Penn all-star her junior and senior seasons. The all-star pitcher completed over 90% of the games she started during her 3 year varsity career.

Missy took her talents to Susquehanna University where she lettered her first three years. Missy missed the majority of her senior year with a back injury. During Missy's freshman year at SU, she went 8-6 in 15 games that she started and compiled a 3.24 ERA. She was 10th in the Middle Atlantic Conference in strikeouts. Missy dealt with a nagging Arm injury the next two years. Her sophomore year, she played in 10 games with a 2.58 ERA and in her 7 games as a junior compiled a 2.17 ERA. Missy finished her career 6th in program history in ERA (2.90) and strikeouts per seven innings and she 8th in career strikeouts and wins. She was also a repeat MAC All-Academic team member.

In 2008, Missy was inducted in the District IV Softball Hall-of-Fame.

Missy coached three years in Muncy Little League with the major softball team and Three years a piece with the Muncy Junior high softball team and the Muncy varsity Softball team assisting head coach Mark Temons.
