Clay lettered on Muncy's first football and basketball teams. He quarterbacked the football team and played guard on the basketball team as both teams made their debut in 1926. Clay's leadership was on display as he captained both teams. Clay then made his name in college as he wrestled for the University of Pennsylvania and captained them his senior year. Pretty good for not having wrestled in high school as the sport didn't start at Muncy until 1937. He was a three time letter winner at Penn. Clay returned to his Alma mater, Muncy and helped George Wilt start up wrestling in 1937. Clay got some old mats and worked with the wrestlers on the moves he had learned at college. Clay was the assistant coach in 1938 and 1939. He then took over as head coach for Muncy as their current coach Phil Traupane left for the service. Clay coached Muncy's second State Champ-Harold Hill.
