During Mike's three years as the Muncy Quarterback he completed 280 passes for 4,497 yards and threw 51 touchdown passes. Mike was selected as the Sun-Gazettes all area team QB and the District IV website selected him Class A Most Valuable Player his senior year. Mike played one year of college football at Ursinus college. Mike also lettered one year in track his freshman year at Ursinus College.

Mike lettered three years in basketball, and was Capt. his senior year. He was a first team Mid-Penn all-star his 11th and 12th years. Mike was player of the week three times and was selected to three all-tournament teams. He made 83 3-pointers his senior year.
