Arlene and James Opp and Howard Opp Scholarship Fund

- Attend an accredited institution of higher education
- Plans to pursue a degree in a business or medical related field of study
- Preference given to applicants pursuing a business degree
- Business degrees shall include, but are not limited to, finance/banking, accounting, entrepreneurship or economics
- Medical degrees shall include, but are not limited to, pre-medical, nursing or physician assistant
- Must have demonstrated financial need

Daniel C. Berninger Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Must be a graduating senior(s) from Muncy High School who has been accepted to and will attend an accredited college, university, or vocational school or program.
- Scholarship recipients must demonstrate an active role in the school or within the Muncy community. This may include participating in a school club, athletic team, church group or extracurricular activity.
- Preference shall be given to a student who demonstrates qualities that are reflective of Dan, which includes: Leadership and/or serving others. Showing a positive attitude when working with others. A person that is kind, humble, and dedicated to the betterment of the Muncy community.

H. Porter Rathmell Scholarship Fund

- Attend an accredited institution of higher education

Journey Bank Scholarship Fund

- Attend an accredited college, university or trade school in Pennsylvania
- Must be ranked in the top 40% of the graduating class
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Preference given to applicants who have participated in at least one extracurricular activity
- Secondary preference given to applicants who are or whose parents/guardians are customers of Muncy Bank & Trust Company. This is not a requirement to be considered for the award.

Kenneth and Sandra Gardner Leadership Scholarship Fund

- A graduating senior of Muncy Jr./Sr. High School who has been accepted in a college or university to further his/her education pursuing a degree in engineering, nursing or pre-medical.
- Academically in the top 25% of the senior class.
- A good citizen who shows leadership qualities and has good moral character.
- Applicant must show leadership qualities by meeting two of the following three criteria.
 - Captain or co-captain of a recognized varsity sport.
 - An officer of a high school sanctioned organization or club.
 - An Eagle Boy Scout or a Gold Award Girl Scout.

- 2 Scholarships awarded in the **Muncy Jr/Sr High School**, one to a student majoring in a **health care-related field** and one to a student majoring in a **business-related field**.
- Attend an accredited institution of higher education
- Financial need may be a consideration
- Must have a minimum 85% GPA, good attendance, and a positive school performance

Margaret E. Waldron Memorial Fund

- One male student, one female student
- Attend an accredited institution of higher education
- Must have completed grades 10,11,12 at Muncy Jr./Sr. High School
- Must rank in upper 1/5 of the class for Junior and Senior years
- Must be in good standing in both studies and deportment

Muncy Alumni Wrestling Scholarship Fund – nomination by coach

- Attend an accredited institution of higher education
- Attended Muncy Jr./Sr. High School for at least two (2) years
- Has attained at least two (2) varsity letters in the sport of wrestling
- Demonstrated qualities of good character and integrity
- Involved in extra-curricular activities and clubs

Muncy Rotary Club Scholarship Fund

- Attend, full-time, an accredited institution of higher education
- Exhibit community involvement
- Other than a strong potential for success, such factors as class rank and grade point average will not be criteria in making a selection unless such factors are needed to distinguish between multiple potential candidates
- Although the scholarship is not based on need, it may be a considering factor in the selection process

Muncy Scholars Award Fund

- Attend, full-time, an accredited four-year institution of higher education
- Attended Muncy High School from freshman year through senior year
- Selected from the top ten (10) academic performers
- Attained at least one varsity letter in either in sports or band
- Exhibits continued growth in his/her citizenship
- Possess qualities of leadership, honesty and integrity
- Determined to succeed

Ritter Family Scholarship Fund

- Graduating senior from the Muncy School District
- Pursing a degree in business, finance or engineering
- Has participated in volunteer activities that enhance the community of Muncy
